## SECURITY DURING HOLY WEEK

As 'Holy Week' in Colombia approaches, we would like offer the following SECURITY TIPS to protect your home and family during these days.

- Make sure your home's windows, both internal and external, are safely closed. Generate a feeling of SECURITY.
- Turn off all circuit breakers in your home. Verify and close your home's main water and gas shut-off valves.
- Do not leave valuables visible from the outside of your home.
- Trimming tall plants can reduce the possibility of these being used as 'natural ladders' that facilitate access to burglars.
- Ask someone you trust to routinely check the status of your home and provide contact information in the event of an emergency.
- Do not leave key duplicates under rugs, flowerpots or door frames.
- Keep minors and the elderly under supervision during your travels. Frequently check over valuables in airports and concurred places. Thieves take advantage of public places to commit crimes.
- There is a higher risk of disease spread due to poor practices (undercooking) and cold-chain disruption) in seafood during 'Holy Week'. Avoid seafood in unknown or poorly trusted establishments.
- · Facemasks are mandatory nationwide as well as in most other countries. Always carry your vaccination certificate digitally or physically.

- REPORT ANY SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITIES AT AIRPORTS
