OBSERVE AND PREVENT

Being forewarned of suspicious situations is very important.

Some actions that could be cause for alert, are:

- That there is a person using a cellphone inside the bank
- Identify if there is a frequent entry and exit of one or more individuals.
- Gestures or actions that may indicate a language between one person and another.

IF THIS TYPE OF ACTION OCCURS, IT IS VITAL TO INFORM THE BANK'S SECURITY OFFICERS OR THE POLICE DIRECTLY IN ORDER TO ALERT AND PREVENT A CRIMINAL ACT FROM OCCURRING.

RECOMMENDATIONS





- Don't comment on future transactions
- Do not display money while waiting for your shift or when leaving the office
- When withdrawing large amounts of money, it's best to request the company of a police officer
- Avoid using public transportation
- Store cash correctly
- Avoid routine in travels
