## MILLIONAIRE TOUR

According to the Penal Code, the “millionaire tour” is a form of extortive kidnapping. In this type of kidnapping, criminals approach their victims, generally when they are looking for public or private transportation on the street, and deprive them of their freedom for a few minutes or hours, with the aim of emptying their bank accounts and robbing them of their belongings.

Once in the vehicle, the criminals generate fear in the victim through threats, intimidation, violence and even resorting to the use of narcotic substances to avoid resistance. Meanwhile, the criminals go to various ATMs and areas of the city to carry out transactions with the victim's cards and information.

Usually, once the crime is over, the criminals leave the victim in a distant and uncrowded part of the city.

## RECOMMENDATIONS



### PLEASE TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE FOLLOWING SECURITY RECOMMENDATIONS TO AVOID BECOMING A VICTIM OF A “MILLIONAIRE TOUR”

-  **Use the official applications of the transportation companies to avoid incidents.**
-  **In public spaces, always be alert, especially when taking transportation.**
-  **Do not always use the same routes, this way it will be more difficult for criminals to identify you as a possible victim.**
-  **Avoid withdrawing large sums of money in public spaces and particularly if you are going to use a public transportation service.**
-  **Do not allow strangers to enter the ATM with you, and do not accept help in making your transaction.**
-  **Change personal passwords frequently and do not write them down anywhere.**
-  **Periodically review the status of your account and report any warning signs to the bank.**
-  **If you notice that the driver of the cab or private car is behaving suspiciously, get out of the vehicle immediately and report the situation to the transportation companies.**
-  **Always share your trips with family or friends.**
